

## PROIBIDO CLARETE | 2021

A wine made with grapes from the Upper Douro, namely from a 60-year-old vineyard, from a selection of red grapes from native regional varieties. A wine “as it used to be”, with structure, body and freshness.

**Region:** DOC DOURO

**Source:** Upper Douro Sub-Region

**Grape Varieties:** 100% red grapes (Tinta da Barca, Tinta Amarela, Tinta Francisca, Rufete and others)

**Soil:** Schist

**Production:** 6.400 Bottles 0,75L

**Vinification:** The grapes were stomped by foot in a small *lagar*, fermentation started spontaneously and then the wine was pressed. The remaining fermentation took place in used barrels and aged for 6 months.

Alcohol: 12% | Total Acidity: 6.2 g/L | Residual Sugar: 1.0 g/L | Free SO<sub>2</sub>: 15 mg/L | pH: 3.60
