

PROIBIDO GRANDE RESERVA | 2020

The Proibido wine comes from old vineyards having between 40 and 80 years old planted in Vila Nova de Foz Côa. These vineyards are small plots facing north or east between 250m and 500m altitude. All field work is practically done by hand without the use of herbicides or pesticides. When necessary, we plow the land with the help of an horse.

Grape Varieties: 100% old vines

Solo: Schist

Production: 4.000 Bottles 0,75L

Vinification: The grapes were stomped in a small *lagar*. Fermentation started spontaneously and lasted approximately 30 days. It then aged for 15 months in used barrels.
